DESCRIPTIONS

YOUNG THREES: MY MAMA'S A LLAMA

Our popular half-day program for children turning three by September.

We will put on our soft fuzzy Llama tails and ears each day as we journey through our adventure to help Lulu Llama find her mama, inspired by the stories of Deborah Guarino. In our final week we will meet the real Lulu Llama and her mama, Dolly Llama, and Aunt Sugar Plum (Lucy School llama residents). Join us the last day to celebrate our adventures and share our llama stories with a llama dance party. A lovely introduction to Lucy School's preschool program taught by our talented and loving Mimi Lopez. **Thursdays & Fridays, July 11 – August 2, 9:00 – 11:45 AM.**

SESSION ONE: JUNE 24 – JULY 3

Preschool – Kindergarten: Journey to the Moon and Beyond.

We'll turn our large barn space into the galaxy (creating stars and planets to hang from netting), fashion our own spacesuits and gear, build a rocket ship and blast off into outer space. What planets will we visit? What adventures will be had there? Our journey is no more limited than our imaginations! Parents, in role of news reporters, will be invited to interview returning astronauts. Lucy School's music, movement teacher, Christine Galante. **8-day camp.**

Rising Kindergarten - 2nd grade: Moving Through Math

Come clap, drum, shake, dance and slide your way into a fun and active mathematical experience! Join Brittney Delauter Smith in this six-day math camp for students entering kindergarten through second grade. Children will spend time dancing with Mr. Line and Ms. Curvy, flipping Brother Triangle on his pointy head, and solidifying early mathematical concepts through a hands-on approach. Plenty of free play indoors and out will be integrated into our day. At the end of this camp, parents are invited to join us for a mathematical celebration! **Mondays-Wednesdays.**

Rising 3rd – 6th grade: Full STEAM Ahead, June 24 – June 28, with extension option, STEAM On, July 1-July 3

June 24-28. Campers will use art, literature, and music to investigate the Sun, Geometry, Chemistry, and collaboratively explore, indoors and out. Camp director, Sharon Drake, has been a secondary math educator for 28 years, trains math teachers, and has received national, state, and local awards for her teaching. **9:00 AM – 3:00 PM**
July 1-3. STEAM On: Experience a challenging 3-day engineering adventure. Campers will use innovation, team work, and problem-solving strategies to build and design simple machines. This mini-camp is an extension of Full STEAM Ahead and works nicely as a stand-alone 3-day camp! **9:00 AM – 3:00 PM**

Rising 6th -9th grade: Lucy School Sleepaway Camp

June 24 - 28 Join us for a traditional sleep away camp at Lucy School. We will spend our days, hiking and exploring, kayaking and canoeing around our pond, and creating art projects with materials found on our 17-acre property. Our evenings will be filled with cooking nutritious meals, storytelling around a campfire, stargazing, and camping out. We will experience the true nature of community and the tranquility of nature and develop self-reliance. Amy Fonss is a math teacher at Lucy Middle with a talent for crafting and creating. Sophie Huntington is Chair of Lucy School's middle school program and a humanities teacher. She brings a passion for hiking, crafting, and camping.

SESSION TWO: JULY 8 – JULY 19

Preschool – 2nd grade: Anansi the Trickster

Anansi the Spider has promised Tiger that he can catch Snake alive and invites us to help him. We will be traveling to Anansi's various homes in the villages and forests of West Africa, then on to Jamaica, helping Anansi blend magic and mischief as we encounter various dilemmas. Taught by our amazing teachers, Jill Brenner and Mimi Lopez.

- Mondays through Wednesdays: Pre-k and Kindergarten classes will make spider puppets and story boxes for creating our own Anansi stories. Stories we will dance, sing and dramatize include: *Tiger and Anansi*, *Tiger Soup*, and *Anansi does the Impossible*.

- Mondays through Fridays: 1st-2nd graders will explore our woods, pond, waterfall and fields and discover the magic and mischief of nature. Their work will culminate in writing and performing their own Anansi play based on their explorations, to be presented at the Festival (see Creating a Festival below).

Rising 3rd through 6th grade: Creating a Festival: It's Elemental!

Learn how to put your ideas to life, be a leader, work in a team and create a real FESTIVAL. We will devise, plan and bring to life a theatrical happening! Through creative movement, music, drama and art activities we will learn ancient and modern stories about elements of the world and states of matter. Based on our exploration, we will create a festival full of creative activities, installations, theatre sketches and games both indoor and outdoor. The festival will be open to the whole community to unite people in exploring theatre and nature. This camp led by Natasha Mirny, stage director, founder of Happy Theater (www.happytheater.com), and teaching artist for several DC arts programs – Imagination Stage, Synetic Theatre, Inner City Inner Child, Wolf Trap. **Two weeks. Mondays through Fridays.**

SESSION THREE: JULY 22 – AUGUST 2

Grades Preschool – 5th grade: The Imagination Project Camp

Liz Hough is delighted to bring her popular week-long annual arts camp, focusing on art in nature, to Lucy School this summer. This camp is for children entering Preschool – 5th grade. We will begin each day with yoga practice followed by time with a guest artist as a large group and then divide into small age groups. Projects will include photography, drawing, canvas panel painting, and 3-dimensional sculpture. Our week-long journey will culminate with a gallery show showcasing your child's work. Camp director, Liz Hough Drake is a professional photographer and owner of Hough Photography, focusing on portraiture in nature. **July 22 - 26, Monday – Friday.**

Preschool – 3rd grade: A Magic Tree House

What a curious thing! Where did that tree house in the giant oak tree come from? It wasn't there yesterday! Inside the Magic Tree House, we will travel to amazing places and find clues to help us along our journey through a series of amusing and entertaining predicaments. Lucy School teachers Christine Galante and Toni Gardiner!

July 29 – August 2, Monday – Friday. Two groups: Preschool – K and Rising 1st – 3rd grade.

Rising 4th – 7th graders: Tinkering Camp

Week One: Miniature Cities

You will be collaborating with fellow campers to research, plan and build a miniature city, with moving parts, using recycled materials. During the week, City dwellers will vote on issues that arise and determine how their city will run. Taught by our very own Christine Galante. **July 22 - July 26, Monday – Friday**

Week Two: Tinker Creations:

Starting with basic woodworking, and getting familiar with tools, we'll guide you through the process of designing, creating and ultimately using your self-made projects. In an atmosphere of fun and co-creation you learn more about yourself, working with others, while gaining insights on construction methods. Projects may range from building a simple bird-house through making your own clubhouse to making a pond boat for sailing on Lucy School's very own Willow Tree Pond. If you don't mind a bit of paint here and there, join this amazing camp where work and play go hand in hand. **July 29 – August 2, Monday – Friday**

SESSION FOUR: August 5 – AUGUST 9

Preschool – 5th grade Dog Days of Summer

This is our five-day, end of summer, play-based camp. Campers will be divided up into two groups by age. There will be guided activities in music, creative movement and art along with ample free play and exploration indoors and outdoors on our 17-acre campus of woods, fields, hills, pond, waterfall, wetlands and our organic gardens. Outdoor activities will include water play, sensory exploration, and nature-based art. **Monday – Friday.**

Teachers: Christine Galante and Toni Gardiner

Rising 6th – 9th grade. Filmmaking: Shorts.

Learn to tell amazing stories through the medium of digital video! Through interactive, and hands on exercises, students will learn the essentials of filmmaking – screenwriting, shot composition, directing actors and more. Over the final three days, students will work in production teams toward a final project of their choice. The week will conclude with a film festival celebrating everyone's work and attendees will leave camp with a copy of their very own short film. Camp director Jesse Swenson is a filmmaker, writer and musician who began his career as an actor. His acting credits included the Broadway companies of *Spring Awakening* and *The Addams Family Musical*, as well as recurring roles on TV's *Gossip Girl* and *Army Wives*. His short films have toured the land – from Puerto Rico to Provo Utah. He holds an MFA in Film Production from NYU. **Monday – Friday. Teacher: Jesse Swenson, NYC**
